**EACH CONTESTANT IS REQUIRED TO SUBMIT A RESUME**

**Clothing and Safety Equipment Requirements:**

*Competitors* are to wear white tops, black dress pants, black socks or skin-tone hose, and black leather shoes.

*Models* are to wear official Skills USA attire minus the blazer.

**Contest Instructions:**

- **Setup only consists of items needed for specific area of the contest being performed**
- **Time will be given between divisions of competition to reset the table**
- **All products and solutions must be properly identified with manufacturer's original packaging and labeling**
- **Product labels cannot be defaced**
- **Required implements and products must be accounted for and professionally organized**
- **Proper control and usage of products and tools will be expected at all times**
- **All implements to be used must be clean and sanitary**
- **The contestant must cleanse their hands before beginning procedures**
- **Makeup colors should conform to the color of the skin**
- **All work must be completed by hand (no airbrushing)**
- **Sanitation/disinfection will be monitored throughout the contest**

## **Scope of Contest:**

### **Basic Facial Procedures 30 minutes**

Contestant will perform a basic facial procedure to include:

Cleansing, massage and astringent

Not included: steaming and mask

### **Daytime Makeup Application 30 minutes**

Contestant will complete a full-face daytime makeup application. Colors should conform to the models natural skin tone according to the discretion of the contestant. All work must be completed by hand.

### **Fantasy Makeup Application 45 minutes**

All artwork must be done during the fantasy makeup application. (No pre-prep work allowed.)

Items allowed for use in the fantasy makeup application: all makeup products designed for use on the face, grease paint, false eyelashes, rhinestones, feathers and glitter and theatrical accessories

Reference picture only may be brought into the contest area.

### **Equipment/Tools/Materials Provided by the Host School:**

**Table for supplies**

**Reclining chair for model**

**Chair for contestant**

**Hot and cold water**

**Trash receptacles**

### **Equipment/Tools Provided by Contestant:**

- 1. Model: Model must be a student member, but not necessarily from an esthetics program. Hair must be pulled away from the face with a white or black headband. Face must be cosmetic free. Model is not permitted to wear earrings, facial piercings or necklaces. Model is not required to submit a resume.**
- 2. Makeup of choice**
- 3. Washcloth**
- 4. Towels**
- 5. Facial/skincare products of choice**
- 6. Professional Makeup Brushes**
- 7. Disposable Applicators and sponges**
- 8. Headband, Hairclips or Ponytail holders to keep hair back**

- 9. Disinfecting Agent/Hand Sanitizer**
- 10. Fantasy Makeup supplies necessary for your creation (theatrical accessories)**
- 11. Short Makeup Cape (white or black)**
- 12. Portable kit organizer (to transport all items needed for contest)**
- 13. Strip or Individual Eyelashes and Adhesive**
- 14. Light and extension Cord if desired**
- 15. Fast Drying Brush Cleaner**
- 16. A written, brief but specific, description (10 words or less) of the theme they intend to create for the fantasy makeup application**
- 17. One-page, typewritten résumé**

**Other Equipment:**

**No cell phones or two way radios are permitted. If a contestant is found to have either in their possession he/she will be disqualified.**

**Special Instruction and Notes:**

It is impossible for the host school to list all tools you may have instructed your students to use when performing certain tasks. Feel free to bring additional tools you feel you may require to work on the project as mentioned in the Scope of Contest.

**The host school and judges reserve the right to check all tool boxes and/or tools or materials prior to the contest. Any tools that they feel will give the contestant (in their opinion) an unfair advantage will not be permitted.**
