Contest: Nail Care

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EACH CONTESTANT IS REQUIRED TO SUBMIT A RESUME

Clothing and Safety Equipment Requirement:

***Competitors* are to wear black pants, black socks or skin-tone hose, white top and black leather shoes.**

***Models* are to wear official Skills USA attire minus the blazer.**

Scope of Contest:

- ✓ **30 minutes - two tone sculptured nail application on model's right hand, index and middle fingers**
- ✓ **30 minutes – tip and wrap application on model's right hand, ring and little fingers**
- ✓ **60 minutes -**

Safety Requirements:

All implements to be used must be clean and sanitary.

The contestant must cleanse their hands before beginning procedures.

The contestant and model must wear safety glasses.

The same manufacturer must produce the acrylic and monomer.

The same manufacturer must produce the resin and catalyst.

Equipment/Tools/Materials Provided by the Host School:

Table and two chairs.

Equipment/Tools Provided by Contestant:

1. Safety glasses for contestant and model
2. White terry towels, no holes or stains allowed
3. Hand sanitizer
4. All items necessary to complete sculptured acrylic nails. *PLEASE NOTE:* White and pink acrylic is needed for the two -tone application.
5. All items necessary to complete tip and wrap nails. *PLEASE NOTE:* activator/catalyst, resin/adhesive and fiber must be from the same manufacturer.
6. Dark red polish
7. All items necessary to complete flat-paint nail art application. Limited to polish, lacquer, paints and sealer. Top coat may be used as a sealer.
8. Written description of nail art theme, typewritten and contained in a plastic sleeve. *NOTE:* Due at contest check in.
9. A 4 X 6 color photo of nail art to be created during the contest. *NOTE:* Due at contest check in.
10. Portable kit organizer
11. Optional: table lamp and extension cord

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED:

1. Nail art accessories including: gems, skins feathers, rhinestones, glitters, threads, fabrics, foils, beads, tapes, jewelry, air brushing, decal, stencils or cast moldings.
2. Free edge or well tips
3. Tip blenders
4. Top coats or base coats. *NOTE:* top coat or sealer is permitted for nail art application only.
5. Electric files/drills
6. Oil, lotion and buffing crème

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- There will be no conversation between the contestant and the model.
- All products must be properly identified with the manufacturers original packaging and original labeling. No defacing of labels is permitted.
- All nail artwork and polishing must be done during the wearable nail art application.

Other Equipment:

No cell phones or two way radios are permitted. If a contestant is found to have either in their possession he/she will be disqualified.

Special Instruction and Notes:

It is impossible for the host school to list all tools you may have instructed your students to use when performing certain tasks. Feel free to bring additional tools you feel you may require to work on the project as mentioned in the Scope of Contest.

The host school and judges reserve the right to check all tool boxes and/or tools or materials prior to the contest. Any tools that they feel will give the contestant (in their opinion) an unfair advantage will not be permitted.
