<b>Enthusiasm</b>	Enthusiasm for program selected clearly persuasive, upbeat, and positive.	Demonstrated some enthusiasm for program selected.	Little or no enthusiasm for program selected.
<b>Response to Questions</b>	Responses to questions appropriate, unique, and engaging.	Responses to questions may have a few problems, but generally are appropriate. Did not require much, if any, restating or rephrasing of questions.	Unresponsive to some questions even when questions were repeated or rephrased; many responses were confusing, inaccurate, vague, lacked detail, and/or irrelevant.
<b>Appearance and Demeanor</b>	Professional dress AND professional demeanor (engaged listener, respectful, tactful, eager to engage in discussion).	Appropriate dress; Demeanor is respectful and tactful.	Dress is inappropriate or unkempt; Unprofessional (late arrival, argumentative, disrespectful).
