The greenhouse covering on GH #1 at school is in its 4 plus year and the treated lumber needs replaced at the bottom of the house as well. These will need replaced before fall / winter of 2023.going to look into replacing the drip tube for baskets in GH #2.

Class is going to look into replacing the water feature in the 2nd courtyard and replacing some of the older plant material tied to NOCTI plant list.
